1. General Goal

The Japan Public Health Association (JPHA) is a non-profit foundation devoting to promotion of public health and improvement of healthy life of the Japanese people. The activities and programs of JPHA areas follows;

7. Survey and Research Programs on Public Health

I Programs under the subsidy of Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare

JPHA has established the Comprehensive Community Health Promotion Committee to promote the community health activities through the following programs.

(1) Comprehensive Research Program on Community Health

In order to promote the comprehensive and effective community health activities, the nationwide objective survey of the needs for community health activities, the test of their validity and the dissemination of their outcomes have been conducted since 1994 under the cooperation with such nationwide organizations as the Japanese Association Health Directors of Prefectural Governments, the Japanese Association of Public Health Center Directors, the Japanese Association of Chief Public Health Nurses of Public Health Centers, the Japanese Federation of Chief Mental Health and Welfare Centers and Japanese Association of Public Health Center Registered Dietician.

(2) Planning and Training Programs

JPHA plans and implement trainings for the personnel in health, medical services and welfare services. This program includes the assistance training for the municipal health centers, the community health personnel training of the medical system reform, the trainings for public health nurses in the community, and the training for the heads of public health nurses.

(3) Provision of Health Information

JPHA provides the comprehensive community health information, for example, the provision of the literatures relating to the community health, and the information dissemination of the unique activities of community health.

- II Programs entrusted by Ministry of Health, Labor and Welfare and Prefectures
- (1) Aid to the atomic bombed victims living abroad for their health promotion and medical care (entrusted by the governments of Hiroshima Prefecture and Nagasaki Prefecture).
- (2) Aid to dispatch the specialists (DHEAT: Disaster Health Emergency Assistance Team) and (IHEAT: Infectious Disease Health Emergency Assistance Team) of Public Health to the local government and give training them as part of disaster prevention measures.
- JPHA assists the government in coordination the dispatch of DHEAT (Disaster Health Emergency Assistance Team) and public health nurse team.
- JPHA manages the national DHEAT council and regional DHEAT councils to strengthen cooperation among local governments across a wide area.
- JPHA manages and operates the DHEAT dispatch coordination system and the widearea public health nurse and others dispatch coordination system.
- JPHA manages and operates the IHEAT operation support system, and plans and implements training for DHEAT, IHEAT and others, and develops training materials.

8. Management of "Ko-Shu-Eisei Building"

JPHA operates the management and maintenance of the "Ko-Shu-Eisei Building."
